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## Adding Creative Embellishments

### Block 1 - To All A Good Night

If desired, use Pine Needles embellishment kit HNS12 for To All A Good Night to add embellishments. Use the photo on the front cover as a guide for placement.

- 12 Jingle Bells for reindeer H and I harnesses
- 7 – 5mm silver ball beads for reindeer F and G harnesses
- 9 – 4mm silver ball beads for reindeer D and E harnesses
- 16 – 3mm silver ball beads for reindeer A, B and C harnesses

To sew on bells and silver ball beads - take a stitch up through the back of the quilt, through the bell loop or hole in bead and back down through the quilt and tie off.

- 30" of #16 Kreinik braid ctm 6240/02 1-0 copket for reindeer reins
- 11 red #8 seed beads for harness

To attach reins – thread the braid onto a large eyed needle and pull the braid up through the quilt then back down where desired and tie off. McKenna started from below Santa's mittens then strung it behind and on top of the reindeer adding a red seed bead at the bottom of the loose reins under the mittens, tying a knot in the braid to secure the cut off ends and where each rein crossed over the harnesses. Where the red bead crosses the harness, run a strand of thread on a needle up through the bottom of the quilt and through the red bead then back down through the quilt and tie off. This will secure the red bead to the harness.

- Red Swarovski crystal for Rudolph's nose – use hot fix crystal iron or glue on
- 12" of 3 strands - light brown embroidery floss for reindeer eyelids A through D
- 12" of 3 strands - dark brown embroidery floss for reindeer eyes A through D
- 6" of 2 strands – lavender embroidery floss for bunny's eyes
- Add eyelids to reindeer using the light brown floss – take a stitch up through the back of the quilt and sew a single straight stitch and pull back down through quilt and tie off.
- Add eyes to reindeer using the dark brown floss – take a stitch up through the back of the quilt, sew a French knot stitch and pull back down through the quilt and tie off.
- Repeat above using lavender floss to add eyes to the bunny.

## **Block 2 - Making Friends**

If desired, use Pine Needles embellishment kit HNS13 for Making Friends to add embellishments. Use the photo on the front cover as a guide for placement.

- 3 coal beads for the front of snow bear
- 4 black seed beads for the bear eyes
- 22 clear red fringe beads for the berries on the bush
- To sew on coal beads, seed beads and red fringe beads - take a stitch up through the back of the quilt, through the hole in bead and back down through the quilt and tie off.

## **Block 3 - By the Light of the Moon**

If desired, use Pine Needles embellishment kit HNS14 for By the Light of the Moon to add embellishments. Use the photo on the front cover as a guide for placement.

- Tree O – 6 pale blue and 9 light purple Swarovski crystals - use hot fix crystal iron or glue on
- Tree N – 7 red, 4 blue and 8 green Swarovski crystals – use hot fix crystal iron or glue on
- Tree M – 1 large clear star, 3 small clear stars, 5 blue leaf beads, 9 clear/crystal bugle beads, 36 clear/aurora faceted beads and 95 ruby seed beads – string beads as desired onto strong thread then attach to quilt by taking a stitch up through the back of the quilt, over the bead strand, then back down through the quilt and tie off.
- Wreath – 7 red and 5 green Swarovski crystals – use hot fix crystal iron or glue on
- Cardinal bauble – 1 blue leaf bead, 3 aqua seed beads and 3 clear/aurora faceted beads – string beads as desired onto strong thread then attach to quilt by running string down through the quilt under bird beak and tie off on the back.
- Blue Jay bauble – 1 large aurora drop fringe bead, 7 ruby seed beads, 3 crystal/aurora faceted beads and 1 crystal/clear bugle bead. String beads as desired onto strong thread then attach to quilt by running string down through the quilt under the bird beak and tie off on the back.
- Yellow bird bauble – 2 crystal bugle beads, 3 purple fringe beads, 5 purple seed beads and 1 large purple star. String beads as desired onto strong thread then attach to quilt by running string down through the quilt under the bird beak and tie off on the back.

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### **Block 3 - By the Light of the Moon**

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- Star – Angelina – place a small amount of Angelina fibers between 2 layers of the Applique Pressing Sheet™. Use enough Angelina to make approximately a 2" x 2" piece of Angelina "fabric" when fused. Fuse fibers gently with iron – do not over heat! Trace the applique star onto your fusible web and then fuse it gently to one side of the Angelina fabric. Cut out on traced line, peel off paper backing and position onto quilt behind bear's paw. Place the pressing sheet over the star and gently fuse to quilt block through the pressing sheet.
- 3 - #8 black seed beads for bird eyes and 3 - #11 black seed beads for raccoon and bear eyes. Take a stitch up through the quilt from the back, through the hole in the bead and then back down through the quilt and tie off.

### **Block 4 - High Hopes**

If desired, use Pine Needles embellishment kit HNS15 for High Hopes to add embellishments. Use the photo on the front cover as a guide for placement.

- 3 black seed beads for cardinal eyes – take a stitch from the back of the quilt up through the top and through the hole in the seed bead then back down through the quilt and tie off.
- 3 purple/amethyst Swarovski crystals for stocking A and 3 aquamarine Swarovski crystals for stocking B – use a hot fix crystal iron or glue.

### **Block 5 - First Noel**

If desired, use Pine Needles embellishment kit HNS15 for High Hopes to add embellishments. Use the photo on the front cover as a guide for placement.

- 3 black seed beads for cardinal eyes – take a stitch from the back of the quilt up through the top and through the hole in the seed bead then back down through the quilt and tie off.
- 3 purple/amethyst Swarovski crystals for stocking A and 3 aquamarine Swarovski crystals for stocking B – use a hot fix crystal iron or glue.

## **Block 6 - Ice Capades**

If desired, use Pine Needles embellishment kit HNS17 for Ice Capades to add embellishments. Use the photo on the front cover as a guide for placement.

- 5 – Black seed beads for bear eyes – take a stitch from the back of the quilt through to the top and through the hole in the seed bead then pull thread back through to the back of the quilt and tie off.
- 3” of sparkly, fuzzy white eyelash yarn for bear C’s hat – wrap yarn around pinky finger to make loops – take a few stitches from the back of the quilt through to the top and into and through the yarn to secure it to the hat then pull thread back through to the back of the quilt and tie off.
