

Embellishment Directions

The directions for adding the Creative Embellishments to your *Sea Breeze* quilt blocks or Truly McKenna Art Print Panels are taken directly from the *Sea Breeze* patterns. Please refer to the images on our website *www.pineneedles.com* or on the pattern covers for reference.



SEA01 - The Nerdles

- a. Randomly sew purple seed beads to starfish.
- Sew large seed beads to look like bubbles from the turtles.
- c. Randomly sew sequins to sea sponge anchoring with small clear seed beads.
- d. Randomly sew light yellow seed beads on coral

SEA02 - The Snooty Sisters

- Sew large round beads on seahorse eyes.
- b. Randomly sew sequins to back of seahorse 1 and belly of seahorse 3 anchoring with small clear seed bead.

SEA03 - The Doodles


- a. Sew dark seed beads to pelicans for eyes.
- Randomly sew sequins in water anchoring with small clear seed beads.
- c. Cut and tack pieces of twine to piers.

SEA04 - Tweedle Dee

- Randomly sew fringe beads to the anemone centers.
- b. Randomly sew purple seed beads on starfish 11.
- c. Randomly sew sequins on coral anchoring with small clear seed beads.
- d. Sew one large clear cube bead on bubbles K & I.
- e. Sew one silver lined cube bead on bubbles E, H & J.
- f. Sew one silver lined seed bead on bubbles A, B, C, D, F & G.


SEA05 - Tweedle Dee

- a. Sew sea shell beads on the ocean bottom.
- b. Randomly sew purple seed beads on starfish.
- c. Randomly sew yellow seed beads on coral.
- d. Randomly sew silver lined seed beads on seaweed.
- e. Sew fringe beads to anemone centers.
- Randomly sew light pink sequins to sea sponge anchoring with small clear seed beads.
- g. Randomly sew green sequins to sea lettuce that baby manatee is holding anchoring with small clear seed beads.



SEA06 - Tootsie and Rumples

- a. Sew large seed beads to look like bubbles from the puffer fish.
- Randomly sew sequins in background block
 C anchoring with small clear seed beads.



SEA07 - The Clampetts

- Randomly sew large seed beads to the centers of bottom anemones.
- b. Sew the clear silver lined seed beads to look like bubbles coming from the clownfish.
- c. Randomly sew purple seed beads on starfish 20.
- Randomly sew sequins on seaweed anchoring with small clear seed beads.

SEA08 - Tweedle Dum

- a. Randomly sew blue bugle beads to mahi mahi's back fin.
- b. Sew fringe beads to the grouping anemone centers.
- Sew large seed beads to look like bubbles from the mahi mahi.
- d. Randomly sew the two different orange seed beads on starfish.
- Randomly sew sequins to look like scales on the mahi mahi anchoring with small clear seed beads.

SEA09 - Twinkle Toes

- a. Sew round bead on octopus eye.
- Randomly sew silver lined seed beads to seaweed.
- c. Randomly sew sequins to the dark part of the octopus to look like suction cups anchoring with green yellow lined seed bead.
