Before Getting Started:

Read all instructions before beginning this project to find valuable tips, save time and minimize mistakes by understanding the process before you begin!

Truly McKenna Art Prints are not pre-shrunk. If you are making a project that will be washed after use, you may want to pre-wash your fabrics.

The term WOF refers to width of fabric.

Use an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless instructed otherwise in pattern directions.

Materials Needed:

- One ACU04-P Hello World! Truly McKenna panel
- MR1-66 Autumn - $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for Linings, Backing and Binding
- 1 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square of thick Insul-Bright™ batting
- 1 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square of cotton batting

Preparing Panel and Fabric:

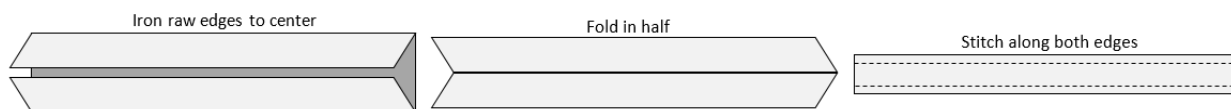
- Trim panel to $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square, centering the image.
- From MR1 -66 Autumn
 - Cut 1 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for Binding
 - Sub cut 1 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" piece for hang tab
 - Cut 1 - 2" x 8" strip for Binding
 - Cut 1 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square for Backing
 - Cut 2 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for Lining and Backing

Pot Holder Front:

1. Layer $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Backing fabric right side down, the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Insul-Bright, the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " cotton batting and the trimmed panel right side up.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Trim to 8" x 8" square.
4. Using the 2" x 8" Binding strip, iron in half-length wise and bind top edge of panel to create the Pot Holder front.

Pot Holder Back:

1. Layer 1 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Backing fabric right side down, the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Insul-Bright, the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " cotton batting, and the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Lining fabric right side up.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Trim to an 8" x 10" rectangle to create the Pot Holder back.
4. Using the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" piece for the hang tab, keeping right side of fabric facing out, iron raw edges toward the center, fold in half again and sew along the edge on both sides.



5. Fold tab in half and center on the top of 8" x 10" quilted panel, lining up the raw edge of the tab with the raw edge of the Pot Holder back and baste in place. *Note: the tab will be pointing downward.

Pot Holder Assembly:

1. Layer the on the Pot Holder back, tab facing up, with the Pot Holder front, right side up.
2. Baste sides and bottom.
3. Refer to Diagram One for cutting corners. Place the 45° line on your ruler on the top edge of the Pot Holder. Line up the ruler so there are 2" from edge to edge and cut off the corner. Repeat for all 4 corners.
4. Bind your Pot Holder, fold tab up and top stitch in place and enjoy!

Alternate Color Combination:

- One ACU03-P Struttin' Truly McKenna panel
- MR2-541 Peace - ½ yard for Linings, Backing and Binding
- 1 - 8½" x 8½" and 1 - 8½" x 10½" square of thick Insul-Bright™ batting
- 1 - 8½" x 8½" and 1 - 8½" x 10½" square of cotton batting
