This project can easily be made in an afternoon for a fun gift or to add something beachy to your own house!

Materials Needed:

- Beach Walk Truly McKenna Art Print Panel: Sunblock (BW05-P)
- Fabric 1: AYC-16315-300 Storm - ½ yard for HST and binding
- Fabric 2: AYC-16314-156 Linen- 1 FQ for HST
- Fabric 3: AYC-16319-300 Storm - ½ yard for backing
- ½ yard of cotton batting or fusible fleece

Before Getting Started:

- HST – Half Square Triangle
- Use ¼" seam allowance

Preparing Panel and Fabric:

- Trim Art Print Panel to 10½" x 30½"
- Fabric 1: Cut three – 2½" strips for binding
- With remainder of Fabric 1 and Fabric 2, make 44 – 2½" HST using your preferred method

Assembly:

1. Arrange HST around trimmed panel to form a "striped awning" effect. Sew HST together in strips and then to the panel. Refer to picture and Diagram 1 for placement.
 - a. Two strips of 17 HST's for the top and bottom
 - b. Two strips of 5 HST's for the left and right sides
2. Sandwich the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Trim Table Runner edges on all four sides, bind and enjoy!!

Optional:

Add some decorative stitching, following McKenna's original stitch lines and a few heat-set crystals for some sparkle!
