

Rockport Basket Large

Pattern by: Aunties Two Size: Large

Using: Truly McKenna Beach Walk Art Print: Water Ballet (BW08-P)

Adaptations:

Trim Art Print to 10½" x 29½".

Made without handles.

**Crossover in front of basket uses the "left side" of panel "on top" due to design elements on the panel.

Fabric 1: AYC-16315-260 Crystal - ½ yard for lining and prairie points

Fabric 2: AYC-16319-20 Amethyst - 1/4 yard for binding

Fabric 3: AYC-16315-20 Amethyst - $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for bottom of basket, $\frac{2}{2}$ " squares and right-side fabric strip

Preparing Fabric for Panel:

Fabric 1: Cut eight - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, make prairie points and set aside

Fabric 3: Cut eight - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; cut one - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle; cut one - $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strip; cut two - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Making Pinwheel Piece:

- 1. Using a $\frac{1}{8}$ " seam sew a prairie point on the top edge of all Fabric 3 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- 2. Arrange four squares so the prairie points make a pinwheel in the center.
- 3. Make two 4½" pinwheel squares.
- 4. Sew them together, add the $1\frac{3}{4}$ " fabric strip to one of the long sides, then the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric strips to the top and bottom.
- 5. Sew the pinwheel piece to the **LEFT** side of panel.
- 6. Sew the 4½" x 10½" fabric strip to the **RIGHT** side of panel.
- 7. Cut and sew your lining piece to panel.

*Using the Beach Walk Art Print - basket will be 1"-1½" taller than original pattern. Take this into consideration when cutting your lining to match size.

**Width is slightly larger, square up the ends after channel quilting is done

You can now continue with pattern as directed.
