


**Cutting Instructions for *Aunties Two Mini Poppins Bag* pattern (#AT629)
Using the "Truly McKenna" Art Print Panel *Bridge Over Troubled Waddles* (IFB07-P)**

Diagrams are not perfectly to scale, but you'll get the gist!

Large Mini Poppins Bag



Cutting Outside Bag Body:

- Find the vertical center of the Art Print Panel and mark with chalk or an erasable marker. Cut along this drawn line.
- Trim each half of the panel down to 10 1/2" tall x 16" wide, or as wide as possible using the seam allowance and the white border. The width should be at least 15 1/2" for the bag front and bag back pieces.

Bag Front and Back Center Lines: *Refer to Page 2 of the pattern*


- To get the bag front and bag back center lines (**purple dotted lines**), measure 7 1/4" from the panel vertical center edge (**red line**) and mark with chalk or an erasable marker. Continue marking the remaining lines on the bag front and bag back as instructed on Page 2 of the pattern.

Cutting Outside Side Sashing:

- Cut 1 - 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" rectangle from each 1 1/4" x WOF Bottom Binding strip. Use the remainder to bind the bottom.

Follow the rest of the pattern instructions to complete your Mini Poppins Bag!

Small Mini Poppins Bag



Cutting Outside Bag Body: Choose placement for the bag front and back. The ducks are so cute, be sure to include them!

- Find the vertical center of the Art Print Panel and mark with chalk or an erasable marker. Cut along this drawn line.
- Trim each half of the panel down to 8 1/2" tall x 16" wide, or as wide as possible using the seam allowance and the white border. The width should be at least 15 1/2" for the bag front and bag back pieces.

Bag Front and Back Center Lines: *Refer to Page 2 of the pattern*

- To get the bag front and bag back center lines (**purple dotted lines**), measure 7 1/4" from the panel vertical center edge (**red line**) and mark with chalk or an erasable marker. Continue marking the remaining lines on the bag front and bag back as instructed on Page 2 of the pattern.

Cutting Outside Side Sashing:

- Cut 1 - 1 1/4" x 10 1/2" rectangle from each 1 1/4" x WOF Bottom Binding strip. Use the remainder to bind the bottom.

Follow the rest of the pattern instructions to complete your Mini Poppins Bag!
