Before Getting Started:

Read all instructions before beginning this project to find valuable tips, save time and minimize mistakes by understanding the process before you begin!

Truly McKenna Art Prints are not pre-shrunk. If you are making a project that will be washed after use, you may want to pre-wash your fabrics.

The term WOF refers to width of fabric.

Use an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless otherwise instructed in pattern directions.

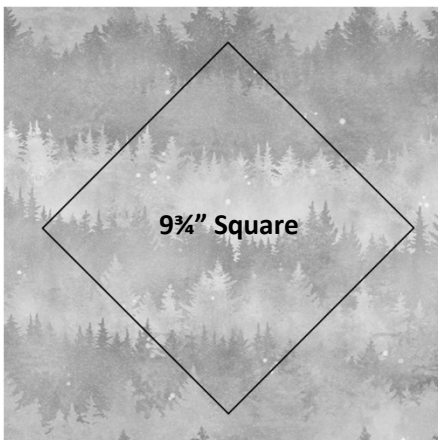
Materials Needed:

- One *OUT04-P Knee Deep Truly McKenna* panel
- Fabric 1: MRD6-52 Cinnamon - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard for Inner Border and Binding
- Fabric 2: MRD4-44 Forest - $1\frac{1}{2}$ yard for Setting Triangles and Backing
- Cotton Batting - 25" x 25" piece

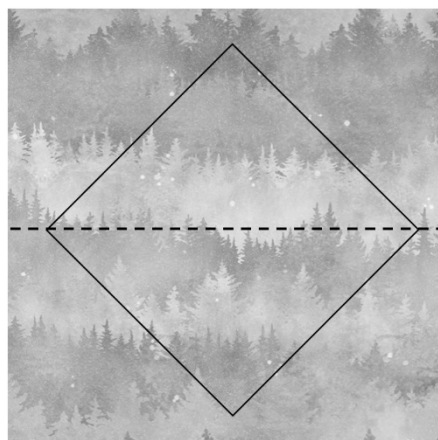
Preparing Panel & Fabric:

- Trim panel to $12\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Fabric 1:
 - Cut 2 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips for Inner Border
 - subcut 2 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{4}$ " for side Inner Border
 - subcut 2 - $13\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ " for top and bottom Inner Border
 - Cut 2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for Binding
- Fabric 2:
 - Cut 1 - 25" x 25" piece for Backing
 - Cut 2 - $9\frac{3}{4}$ " squares on the DIAGONAL *Directional fabric
 - Cut each $9\frac{3}{4}$ " square once, on the diagonal, to get 4 Setting Triangles. *Note: pay close attention to the directional fabric! The diagonal cut for the top and bottom Setting Triangles needs to be cut horizontally *with* the direction of the trees. The diagonal cut for the left and right side Setting Triangles needs to be cut vertically *through* the trees.

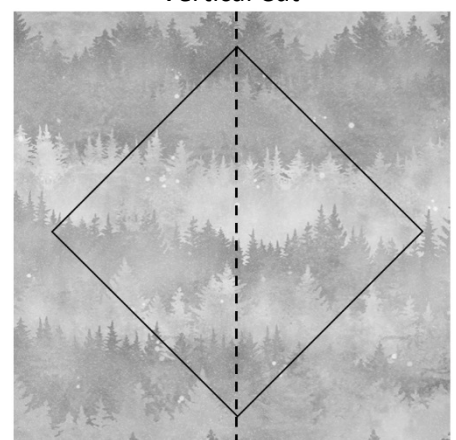
Cut on the Diagonal

Border & Setting Triangles: Refer to Diagram One for assembly.

1. Sew a $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{4}$ " Inner Border strip to the left and right side of the panel. Press seams towards the panel.
 2. Sew a $13\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ " Inner Border strip to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams towards the panel.
 3. Sew the top and bottom Setting Triangles to the panel. Press seams towards the Setting Triangles.
 4. Sew the left and right Setting Triangles to the sides of the panel. Press seams towards the Setting Triangles.
- Completed quilt top should measure 19" x 19".

Quilting & Binding:

Layer Backing fabric right side down, the cotton batting and the panel right side up and quilt as desired.

1. Trim and square edges after quilting.
2. Sew on your binding.
