

These corrections are for the <u>First Edition</u> Road Trip Full Quilt pattern ONLY. These corrections are for the Fish A Placement Guide and the Bear Paw Corner Blocks. The corrected information is in red.

Step 5 - Assembling the Road Trip Quilt

Cut & Piece the Borders

AYC-15474-222 Redwood

- Cut one 3½" x WOF strip and one 2" x WOF strip.
- From the 3½" x WOF strip subcut four 3½" squares for Bear Paws and eight 2½" squares for Bear Claws.
- From the 2" x WOF strip subcut four 2" squares for Cornerstones.

Assemble the Bear Paw Corner Blocks

1. Refer to the diagram below, layer a 2%" square from Pewter and Redwood fabrics together with right sides facing. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the Pewter fabric. Sew a seam ¼" from each side of the drawn line. Cut blocks apart on the drawn line. Press seams towards the Redwood fabric. Carefully trim each to a 2" square. Repeat for the remaining seven 2%" Pewter and Redwood squares to make sixteen 2" half-square triangle blocks for the Bear Claws in the Bear Paw Corner Blocks.

Placement Guide

Refer to the image below for a Placement Guide correction for Fish A. Pieces A10 and A11 placement order have been corrected.
