## Step 5 - Assembling the Road Trip Quilt

## Cut \& Piece the Borders

AYC-15474-222 Redwood

- Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip and one $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
- From the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip subcut four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Bear Paws and eight $27 / \mathbf{z}^{\prime \prime}$ squares for Bear Claws.
- From the 2" x WOF strip subcut four 2" squares for Cornerstones.


## Assemble the Bear Paw Corner Blocks

1. Refer to the diagram below, layer a $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square from Pewter and Redwood fabrics together with right sides facing. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the Pewter fabric. Sew a seam $1 / 4 "$ from each side of the drawn line. Cut blocks apart on the drawn line. Press seams towards the Redwood fabric. Carefully trim each to a $2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat for the remaining seven $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Pewter and Redwood squares to make sixteen 2" half-square triangle blocks for the Bear Claws in the Bear Paw Corner Blocks.
