This correction is for the Second Edition Road Trip Full Quilt pattern ONLY. This correction is for the half-square triangle blocks used to create the Bear Paw Corner Blocks. The corrected information is in red.

## Step 5 - Assembling the Road Trip Quilt

## Assemble the Bear Paw Corner Blocks

1. Refer to the diagram below, layer a $27 /{ }^{7 \prime \prime}$ square from Pewter and Redwood fabrics together with right sides facing. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the Pewter fabric. Sew a seam $1 / 41$ from each side of the drawn line. Cut blocks apart on the drawn line. Press seams towards the Redwood fabric. Carefully trim each to a $2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat for the remaining seven $27 / s^{\prime \prime}$ Pewter and Redwood squares to make sixteen 2" half-square triangle blocks for the Bear Claws in the Bear Paw Corner Blocks.
