

# Road Trip

This correction is for the **Second Edition** Road Trip Full Quilt pattern ONLY. This correction is for the half-square triangle blocks used to create the Bear Paw Corner Blocks. The corrected information is in **red**.

## **Step 5 - Assembling the Road Trip Quilt**

### **Assemble the Bear Paw Corner Blocks**

1. Refer to the diagram below, layer a  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square from Pewter and Redwood fabrics together with right sides facing. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the Pewter fabric. Sew a seam  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line. Cut blocks apart on the drawn line. Press seams towards the Redwood fabric. **Carefully trim each to a 2" square**. Repeat for the remaining seven  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Pewter and Redwood squares to make sixteen 2" half-square triangle blocks for the Bear Claws in the Bear Paw Corner Blocks.
