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Rag Quilt Featuring Painted Forest[™] Fabrics (2nd Edition)

Finished Quilt: 38½" x 42½"

Before Getting Started:

Read all instructions before beginning this project to find valuable tips, save time and minimize mistakes by understanding the process before you begin!

If you are making a project that will be washed after use, you may want to pre-wash your fabrics.

The term WOF refers to width of fabric, and LOF refers to length of fabric.

Use an accurate 1/2" seam allowance unless instructed otherwise in pattern directions.

Materials Needed:

- MRD3-D21 Dusty Teal 3% yard for quilt top + 2 yards for Backing
- MRD6-31 Emerald- 3/2 yard
- MRD3-220 Fern- ¼ yard
- MRD2-58 Earth 1¹/₈ yard
- 2 yards of batting OR crib size
- Cotton thread to match
- Walking Foot recommended
- Very sharp pointed scissors or Rag Snipping shears

Cutting Quilt Fabrics:

From MRD3-D21 Dusty Teal

- Cut 2 6" x WOF strips subcut 12 4¾" x 6" for Pieced Rows
- From MRD6-31 Emerald
 - Cut 2 5½" x WOF strips
 - $\circ~$ trim each to 5½" x 38½" for Top and Bottom rows
 - Cut 2 7¾" x WOF strips
 - subcut 6 7¾" x 7¾" squares for Center Diamond blocks
 - Cut each once diagonally

From MRD3-22 Fern

• Cut 1 - 6" x WOF strip - subcut 6 - 6" x 6" squares for Pieced Rows

From MRD2-58 Earth

- Trim both selvages off the fabric
 - Cut 2 6" x LOF strips from each trimmed edge
 - \circ trim each strip to 6" x 38½" for Middle Rows.

• Cut 3 - 10" x 10" squares **DIAGONALLY** from the Tree sections of the fabric for Center Diamond Blocks.

From MRD3-D21 Dusty Teal Backing

*Note: Each Backing fabric piece will be cut for the corresponding Quilt Top Block or Row fabric.

- Cut 5 6" x WOF strips
 - o from 2 strips subcut 12 4³/₄" x 6" for the MRD3-D21 Dusty Teal Pieced Rows
 - trim 2 strips to 6" x 381/2" for the MRD2-58 Earth Middle Rows
 - trim remaining strip into 6 6" x 6" squares for the MRD3-22 Fern Pieced Rows
- Cut 2 5¹/₂" x WOF strips
 - $\circ~$ trim each to 5½" x 38½" for the MRD6-31 Emerald Top and Bottom rows
- Cut 2 7¾" x WOF strips
 - o subcut 6 7¾" x 7¾" squares for the MRD6-31 Emerald Center Diamonds
 - cut each once diagonally

- Cut 1 10" x WOF strip
 - o subcut 3 10" x 10" squares for the MRD2-58 Earth Center Diamond blocks

From Batting

*Note: Each Batting piece is cut 1" smaller than the corresponding Quilt Top and Backing fabric pieces.

- Cut 12 3¾" x 5" for the MRD3-D21 Dusty Teal Pieced Rows
- Cut 2 5" x 37½" for the MRD2-58 Earth Middle Rows
- Cut 6 5" x 5" squares for the MRD3-22 Fern Pieced Rows
- Cut 2 4¹/₂" x 37¹/₂" for the MRD6-31 Emerald Top and Bottom rows
- Cut 6 6¼" x 6¼" squares for the MRD6-31 Emerald Center Diamonds
 - cut each once diagonally
- Cut 3 9" x 9" squares for the MRD2-58 Earth Center Diamond blocks

Assembling the Rag Quilt:

Use Diagram One and the photo on the front cover to assemble the quilt. All seams are sewn with **WRONG** sides of fabric facing, with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. A walking foot is recommended but not required.

Making quilt sandwich all Blocks and Rows:

- 1. Place a Backing fabric right side down, layer a batting piece in the center then place a Quilt top fabric right side up making a quilt sandwich. Pin to stabilize.
- 2. Stitch across all three layers as shown in the photo on the front cover, to stabilize the layers.
- 3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 for all Blocks and Rows.

Assemble the Center Diamonds:

- 1. With wrong sides facing, center an MRD6-31 Emerald triangle on one side of a 10" x 10" MRD2-58 Earth Center Diamond and stitch using a ½" seam allowance. Repeat, adding an Emerald triangle to the remaining three sides of the Center Diamond.
- 2. Repeat to create 3 Center Diamonds.
- 3. Sew the 3 Center Diamonds together in a row. Sewn Row should measure 38½" x 13½".

Assemble the Pieced Rows:

- 1. With wrong sides facing, sew together a Pieced Row using 6 4¾" x 6" Dusty Teal blocks and 3 6" x 6" Fern blocks. Sewn Row should measure 38½" x 6".
- 2. Repeat to create 2 Pieced Rows.

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Assemble the Quilt: Refer to photo on cover for correct placement


- 1. Sew all Rows together with wrong sides facing.
- 2. Sew around the perimeter of the Quilt using a ½" seam. Completed quilt top should measure 38½" x 42½".

Snipping and Ragging

- Using a very sharp pointed scissors, snip all seam allowances including the perimeter of the Quilt, approximately ³/₈" deep up and approximately ¹/₄" apart. Be very careful to not clip into the seam stitching.
- 2. Wash in a washing machine using cold water and fabric softener if desired. Remove from washer and shake well to help remove loose fibers.
- 3. Tumble dry using warm setting. Clean your lint filter approximately 20 minutes into the cycle before continuing to dry.
- 4. Fibers will continue to shed with every washing and drying making the quilt softer and fluffier over time. Remove loose fibers with a lint roller if desired.
