Snow Buds™ Wall Hanging with Pocket

12" x 18 ½"

Materials Needed:

- One Snow Buds Art Print
- Fabric 1: 3/4 yard for border, binding, backing, HST and pocket lining
- Fabric 2: Fat 16th for border and HST
- Fabric 3: Fat 8th for heart pocket
- Fabric 4: Fat 16th for heart pocket
- Fabric 5: One FQ for heart pocket edge and backing
- Fusible Fleece: 13" x 20" piece and 7 ½" x 12 ½" piece

Before Getting Started:

- HST = Half Square Triangle
- WOF = Width of Fabric
- RST = Right Sides Together
- Use ¼" seam allowance unless otherwise noted

Cutting:

- 1. Trim Snow Buds Art Print to 8 ½" x 8 ½" square (trim equally on all sides to maintain position of image).
- 2. Fabric 1:
 - a. Cut two 2 ¼" x WOF strips for binding
 - b. Cut one 1 ½" x WOF strip.
 - i. Subcut into four 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips
 - c. Cut one 8 x 12 ½" rectangle for bottom half/pocket lining
 - d. Cut one 13" x 20" rectangle for backing
- 3. Fabric 2: Cut four 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips
- 4. Fabric 1 and 2 leftovers: Make four 2 ½" HST's using your preferred method.
- 5. Fabric 3: Cut four 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles
- 6. Fabric 4:
 - a. Cut four 3 ½" squares
 - b. Cut eight 1 ¼" squares
 - i. Lightly draw a diagonal line on the backside of each square.

7. Fabric 5:

- a. Cut one 8 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle for pocket lining
- b. One 1 ½" x 12 ½" strip bottom border for pocket

Assembly:

Main body of wall hanging:

- 1. Using the 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric 1 and Fabric 2 strips, with RST, sew strips together along the 8 ½" side. Iron seams towards dark fabric. You will have four strip units.
- 2. Using the four HST's and two of the strip units from Step 1, sew HST's to each end of the two strips. Refer to Diagram 2 for placement.
- 3. Sew the two remaining Step 1 strip units to each side of trimmed Snow Buds Art Print. Refer to Diagram 2 for placement.
- 4. Sew the HST/strip units from Step 2 to the top and bottom of Snow Buds Art Print to complete the center of the wall hanging. Refer to Diagram 2 for placement.
- 5. Now take the 8" x 12 ½" Fabric 1 rectangle, with RST, sew to the bottom half of Snow Buds square. Iron seam toward rectangle.
- 6. Lay the front panel right side up onto the 13" x 20" piece of fusible fleece. Fuse, trim fleece even with pieced unit and set aside.



Heart Squares for Pocket:

- 1. Using the four Fabric 3 rectangles, with RST, place two 1 ¼" Fabric 4 squares in the top corners of each Fabric 3 rectangle. Referring to Diagram 1 for direction of drawn lines, sew on drawn line, trim excess away ¼" from sewn line. Do this for all four rectangles and iron seams open.
- 2. Take the 3 ½" Fabric 4 squares and place them on the bottom half of the rectangles, with 2 drawn lines slanting to left and 2 to the right (refer to Diagram 2). Sew on drawn line, trim excess away ¼" from sewn line and iron seams open.
- 3. Join the left and right heart square halves to make two complete heart squares. With RST sew the heart squares together to make a $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- 4. Sew the 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric 5 strip to the bottom of the heart unit. This will be the front of the pocket.
- 5. Lay the pocket front right side up onto the 7 1/2"" x 12 ½" piece of fusible fleece and fuse.
- 6. Using the 8 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric 5 pocket lining rectangle and fused pocket front, with RST, pin and sew along the 12 ½" top edge. "Wrap" the lining around the ½" seam to create a border. Iron, and top stitch between the border and hearts. (Note: Back lining piece will be slightly longer than the pocket front, it will be trimmed later.)

Finishing Up:

- 1. With main body of wall hanging line up the heart pocket section with bottom rectangle, pin to hold in place, sew 1/8" around to secure pocket too main body. Trim all excess fleece and fabric edges. (Should measure 12 ½" by 18 %")
- 2. Layer backing and front of wall hanging. Stitch-in-the-ditch around the panel. Bind wall hanging. Add a hanging tube on back or make tabs with leftover fabric to hang.



